VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

The school allows only necessary visitors and volunteers on the campus and will limit the number of students and staff who come into contact with them.

FACE COVERINGS - We will support students and staff wearing masks by:

Posting signage throughout the campus to wear masks. Teachers and staff will also reiterate the importance of wearing masks at all times.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING - We will support physical distancing by:

Posting signage throughout the campus to walk 6ft apart. Floor signage with dots for cohorts to be 25ft apart from other cohorts and to be 6ft apart within own cohort. Teachers and staff will also reiterate the importance of being 6ft apart.

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

We will support cleaning and maintenance of our campus by:

We have onsite janitorial service who disinfects the bathrooms throughout the day. Classrooms are disinfected daily. The gym is disinfected in between cohort use. Teachers and staff wipe down high touch surfaces in the classroom and tables for lunch/recess.

HYGIENE - We will support routine and frequent handwashing by:

Students wash their hands during scheduled bathroom breaks, recess, and lunch. Students use hand sanitizer before re-entering the classroom each time.

ROUTINE TESTING - We will encourage and support staff testing by:


Staff schedules monthly testing. Onsite designee sends reminders of testing window deadlines and keeps track of the results.
